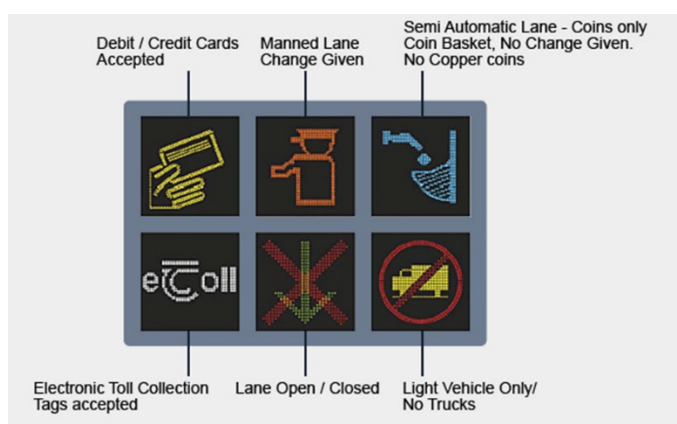
Guidelines for Disabled Drivers in barrier Toll Plazas

(Does not apply to the M50 barrier-free toll)

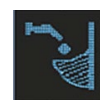
Upon arriving at a barrier Toll Plaza, ILLUMINATED SIGNS located above each toll lane, on the canopy facia, will provide you with information to enable you to choose the appropriate lane for your transit.

Do not use the Express Lanes

The diagram below indicates the ILLUMINATED SIGNS at each Toll Plaza.



If the Manned Lane signal **is** illuminated, then use this lane as there will be a Toll Operator in the lane to assist you



If the Manned Lane signal **is not** illuminated, then use one of the Automatic lanes available

Some Toll Plazas in Ireland are able to recognise those vehicles registered with the Disabled Toll Exemption Scheme (DTES), enabling the toll barrier to lift automatically.

Should the barrier not lift automatically, move forward in the lane until you are adjacent to the Automatic Toll Machine and press the '**Assistance Button**'. This will be clearly visible on the machine. Pressing this button puts a call through to the Control Room where Control Room staff will assist you to transit the plaza.

(Please note that at some Toll Plazas, pressing this button a second or subsequent time, prior to your call being answered, may cause the intercom unit to disconnect)

If you cannot reach the Assistance Button for any reason, remain in the lane. The Toll Plaza Control Room constantly monitors the lanes and will render assistance.
